Notice of Risk Compliance form

I confirm that, in participating in the activities organised and facilitated by the Lincolnshire Association of Woodturners (“**L.A.W.**”), I recognise that woodturning involves the use of high speed electrical machinery and sharp hand tools, which could pose a danger to my personal safety. I accept that the club will risk assess each activity on its own merits and take all reasonably practicable precautions to remove or reduce the risks to an acceptable level. We will implement appropriate controls as deemed necessary but acknowledge that such steps cannot completely eliminate the risk of injury.

I also acknowledge that **L.A.W.** will provide personal safety equipment and have implemented safety measures in the form of:

- (i) Face and eye protectors for members/guests to wear, at all workshop evenings, when using the machinery/tools provided by **L.A.W.** I agree that such equipment must be used if operating all electrical machinery/tools provided and must not be removed from the premises where the workshop evening or event has taken place.
- (ii) Protective screens at each lathe, floor cable covers, safe boundaries around each lathe and a restriction on the use of sandpaper.
- (iii) Ensure all electrical equipment will be P A tested where appropriate.

I am aware that, a maintained first aid kit is available for the trained first aider to use as appropriate, alternatively for use by all, I agree that any injury which I sustain must be reported to a **L.A.W.** committee member and entered into the club accident register.

I support all of these safety measures and relevant controls in place, **L.A.W.** does not accept liability for individual failings and none compliance resulting in personal injury and or damage to equipment caused as a result of acting on individual poor practice.
